Dear Parent and Carers,

We hope you are all keeping safe and well as we move through to the next phase of lockdown. We are looking forward to having all the children back with us soon.

### 8th March 2021 - return to school for all

From 8th March, all primary schools will be open again. Attendance is statutory for all pupils. However, your child should not come to school if:

- They are showing symptoms of coronavirus. They should stay at home, with the household and you should book a PCR test for them.
- They have a confirmed case of coronavirus. They should stay at home for 10 days from the start of their symptoms.
- A member of their household has a confirmed case of coronavirus.
  They should stay at home for 10 days from the onset of symptoms.
- They have been advised to shield. Please send a copy of this advice to the school office.
- They are not well enough for school. Please contact the school office as usual.

We will maintain class bubbles, with the arrangements we had in place previously. Some children have been taught in a different bubble during the school closure, they will return to their original class so please note the start and finish times.

You will find bubble information attached to this email along with revised guidance for parents. This includes your staggered start and finish times.

It still remains the case that class bubbles may be closed to prevent transmission. We will notify you if this is the case.

We have a full risk assessment including matters such as suspected or known infections that we follow in line with NHS guidance. Staff in school will continue to take twice-weekly lateral flow device tests as a proactive protective measure.
