Track and Trace over the Easter holidays

Should a pupil develop symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) between Thursday 1st April up until Wednesday 7th April, please inform the school via email on:

Please send a separate communication for each of your children to the respective email addresses and take your child for a PCR test. These email addresses have been set up specifically for the holiday period only.

If your child tests positive, please email the school on:

- covidreportingjnr@courtlanejnr.co.uk (Juniors)

If your child has been in school and in contact with other children in their class 48 hours before they developed symptoms when they will have been infectious, we will notify all the other parents in their bubble by text and email and they will be advised to self-isolate their children.

The school email will be checked once a day at 10 am and appropriate action will then be taken.

If your child develops symptoms on or after Thursday 8th April you do not need to notify the school but should notify the NHS Track and Trace service.

May we also remind you that it is still illegal for children to have playdates or sleep overs, even if the children are in the same class. We recognise that the measures are limiting and difficult for families, but we urge your continued compliance for everyone's wellbeing.

All adults on school site **must** wear a mask at all times, unless medically exempt. If you are exempt, please ensure you are wearing a lanyard highlighting this, or email the school office so that staff on the gate are aware.
