Children will have their school lunch or packed lunch as usual on their party day but, in addition, we are asking if you could provide a small Christmas snack for your child to enjoy. A single item, no party plates please. Please ensure the snack is brought into school on the morning of their party. In line with our school policy, we request that you do not send anything in that may contain nuts – including chocolate spread.
