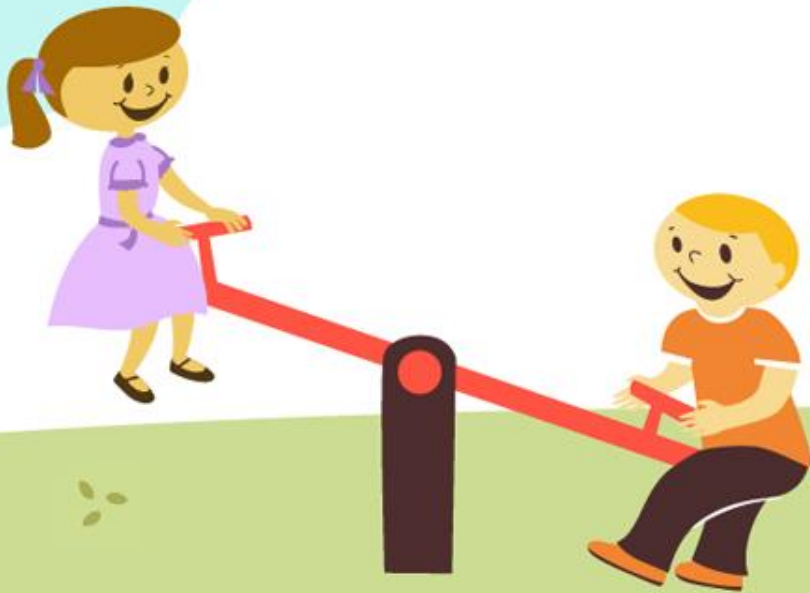

Story map



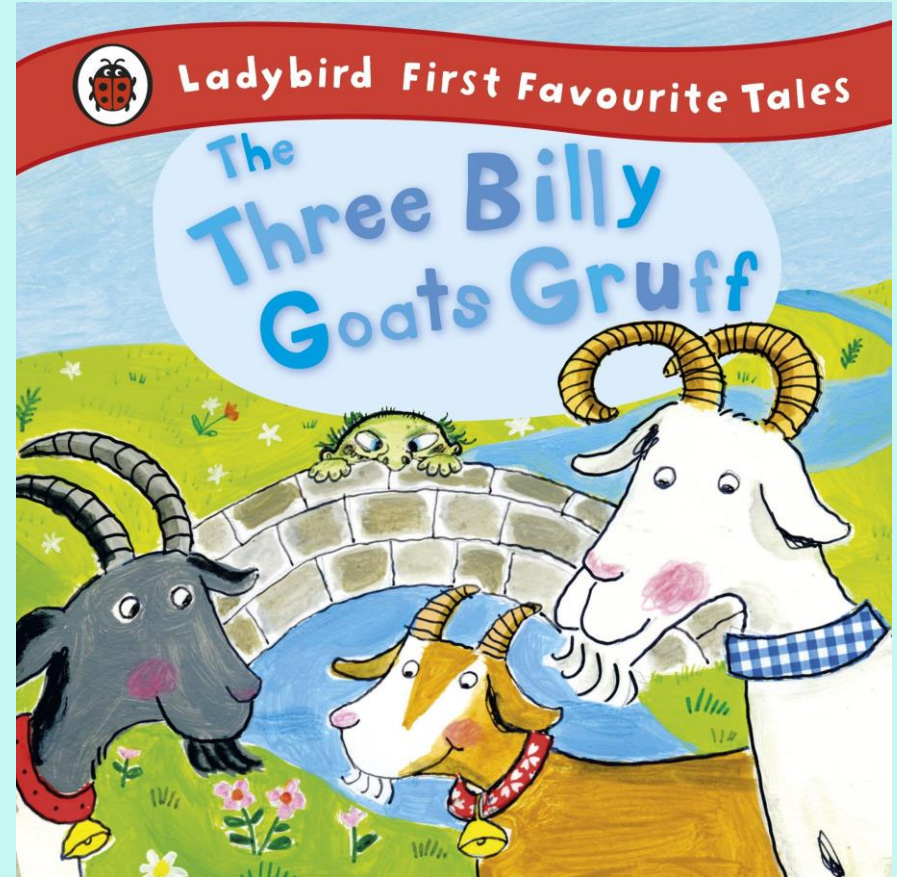
## Drawing a story map.

What happens at the end?



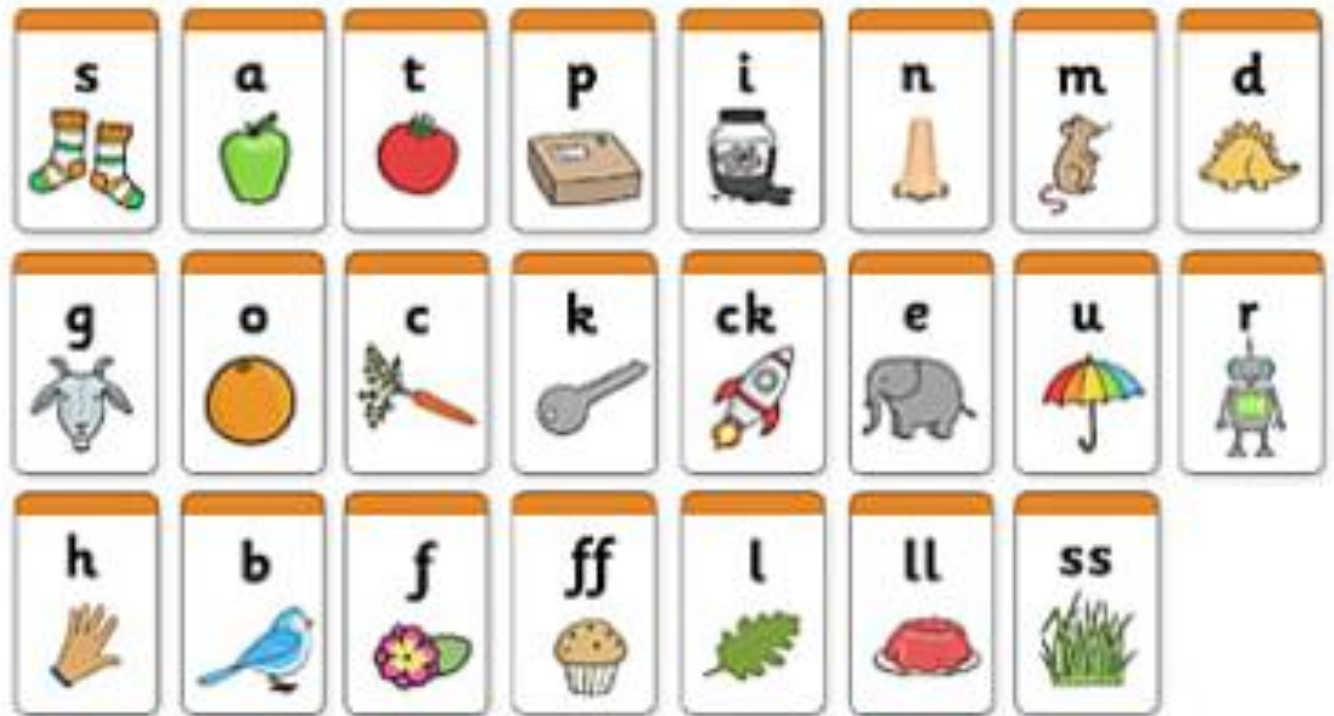
# Writing the sentence

# Writing Discovery Time

- Try some of our other activities with your adult...
  - Draw a picture to go with your writing - you can use any type of paper and writing apparatus. Can you label your picture?
  - Match captions to the correct pictures by reading the sentence and thinking about what it means.
  - Practise writing letter shapes or CVC words on sugar paper using different writing materials
  - Make letters from lego blocks - can you put them together to make a CVC word (it can be real or fake)
  - Act out the story of the Billy goats gruff with the role play masks
  - Make letters from play dough
  - Build a place for the hen to keep her bread using construction
  - Sing Old Mac Donald had a farm together - you can choose the animals!
  - Read non-fiction books about Goats and farm animals - can you tell someone a fact or write it on a whiteboard?
