Junior Parent Survey 2023

Thank you to everyone who responded to our parent survey this half term. We have reviewed every comment and pulled together the key messages which we can take forward to help improve our school. Parent Information Session

Following feedback from parents and carers who were unable to attend our evening event in October about our schools and how we set our priorities moving forward, we have scheduled another session for 9am on Wednesday 24th January in the Junior School Hall. This is an opportunity to learn about what we are working towards and why, as well as ask questions you might have for the leaders from both schools.

Absence

One of the most important ways a parent can support the education of their child and the child's social, emotional and academic development is to ensure they attend every day and on time and avoid any unauthorised absences. Holidays are not acceptable reasons for absence as these are avoidable in term time. Please book these in school holidays. Should the school be compelled to issue fines, this poses a significant cost to the school to be processed. Money from fines does not come to the school. This will have a detrimental impact on the provision for all pupils.

Illness

We know that illness is sometimes unavoidable and to be expected. However it is important to inform the school as soon as possible on the first day of absence, letting us know the reason, by phone, email, letter or in person at the school office so that the absence is authorised. Not all illnesses need time off school. There is a helpful link to NHS guidance on whether or not children can come into school below.
