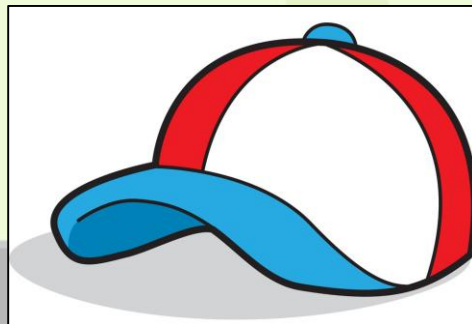

Talking about the sentence

Main Activity - Reading with your child

- Choose a book from the selection at the front.
- Find somewhere comfortable to read together.
- Use the reading bookmark hand-out to support your questions about the story.
- Make sure your child can see a sound mat and tricky word rocket.
- Support your child with sounding out and blending words as they read.
- Ask them to join in with repeating phrases.
- Talk about the book and make predictions as you read.



Questions to Ask

Reading Behaviours

- Where is the front cover?
- What is on the back cover of the book? What does it tell us?
- Where should we start reading?
- Can you glide your fingers under the words as I read?
- Where do I go at the end of the line?
- How many words are on the page?
- How many letters are on the page?
- Where is the capital letter? Is this the only one on the page?
- What is the job of the full stop/question mark/exclamation mark/comma/apostrophe/speech marks?



Comprehension/Word Level

- What do you think will happen in the story?
- Can you find any tricky words?
- Which letters do you recognise?
- Can you sound out this word and blend it together? What does it say?
- Look at the picture - what might the words say?
- How is the character feeling? How do you know?
- How might they say this?
- How did the story end? What might happen after the story has finished?
- Can you retell the story to me using the pictures to help you?
- Who is your favourite/least favourite character? Why?
- Which part of the story was your favourite/least favorite? Why?



Discovery Activities

- Caption and picture matching game
- A range of books to read with your child
- Puppets and small world to retell familiar stories
- Matching CVC words with pictures
- Cut and stick words with pictures
- Bean bag throwing - say a tricky word and throw a bean bag in the correct hoop.
- Capital letters/lower case letter matching game
- Making CVC words to match the pictures
- Initial sound skittles - say the initial sound and try to knock down the correct skittle.
- Rhyming peg game - put the peg on the word that rhyme with the larger picture.
- Real and fake words - can you sort the words into read and fake by sounding out and blending the words together.
