# <u>Literary Theme Week/World Book Day Celebrations</u> $4^{th} - 8^{th} March 2024$

During the week beginning Monday 4<sup>th</sup> March Court Lane Infant School will be holding a Literary Theme Week and celebrating World Book Day. This is to share our love for reading and to look further at our literary heritage. Each year group will be looking at different stories and the famous poem 'I wandered lonely as a cloud' by William Wordsworth. Throughout the week children will have the opportunity to take part in art activities related to the poem.

## World Book Day - Thursday 7th March

On Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March we are asking children to come into school dressed as a character from a book.

Throughout Literary Theme Week and on World Book Day children will have the chance to take part in many exciting activities that link with reading, some examples are as follows...

- · Completing book reviews
- Reading their favourite stories

- Making puppets

Lists will be available in the classroom for signing children out.

The session will be for children and parents to listen to and join in with stories.
